Florida Virtual School® Driver Ed Students Now Able to Take Permit Exam for Free

ORLANDO, Fla. (July 16, 2015) – For the first time, students who successfully complete the [Driver Education/Traffic Safety](#) course with Florida Virtual School (FLVS®) will have the opportunity to take the Florida Learner's License (permit) exam for free. The exam – which is now available online with DriversEd.com – had previously been a separate component that students must pay for through an approved online provider or take at their local DMV.

Any student who successfully completes the FLVS Driver Education course will be sent the link to grant him/her one free Learner's License exam, a savings of almost \$25. When students pass the exam, the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles (DHSMV) will automatically be notified. Students can then visit the DHSMV office to complete the licensing process.

Students will also have the opportunity to take up to 50 free practice tests for the Learner's License exam.

Students completing the Driver Education/Traffic Safety course will also be able to fulfill their virtual learning requirement per Florida's Digital Learning Act.
