Florida Virtual School® Launches New American Sign Language Course



Orlando, FL (April 15, 2019) – In celebration of National American Sign Language Day (April 15), Florida Virtual School (FLVS®) announced the launch of a new course for the 2019-20 school year, American Sign Language (ASL) 1. The full-credit, high school course counts as a world language credit.

This elective introduces students to the basic elements of ASL and broadens cross-cultural understanding of the language and Deaf culture. Students will develop communicative skills in interpersonal, presentational, and interpretive communication, as well as learn all about glossing.
